*** To participate in the on-field activities, you must have purchased your ticket through the Council Service Center, be in uniform, and lined up by 6:30 at the back center field gate of Harbor Park by the Boathouse.**

Units are encouraged to carry their flags on the field.

ONLY Troops, Packs, Crews and Posts are permitted on the field accompanied by uniformed leaders.

(Make sure to hang on to your game tickets for reentry)

**** If you are camping, when you purchase your Tides tickets from Council you will receive a camping voucher for each person.**

To camp at Harbor Park you must follow the same procedures as you would for a Camporee. Webelos may only camp with a Troop and **no other siblings are permitted**, only registered Scouts and adults. **NO OTHER CUB SCOUTS.**

Additionally, only tents without stakes are permitted, and NO ice coolers or kerosene is allowed on the field.

After the game, exit the stadium and collect your camping supplies from your vehicle. To re-enter the stadium, return to the back center field gate and present your camping voucher. Each youth and adult must have their own voucher to enter.

***** Tickets vouchers can be exchanged for seats tickets only at Harbor Park after Saturday, April 1, 2006!**
